Henry Patterson K2DEU to speak

Henry Patterson K2DEU will present a program at the April meeting about his service in WWII. Henry served aboard the USS Quincy, a Baltimore Class Heavy Cruiser in both the Atlantic and Pacific theaters.

The USS Quincy took part in both operation Overlord the D Day invasion of Normandy (stationed on the Right Flank of Utah Beach) and operation Anvil (later renamed Dragoon) the invasion of Sothern France on 15 August 1944.

Later the Quincy was the ship that transported President Roosevelt to and from the Mediterranean on his trip to Yalta for the famous meeting with Churchill and Stalin.

Logging Programs

This month we'll look at some free logging programs. There are basically two types. Those that are configured specifically for contests and those that do general purpose logging but can also be used for contests. First lets check out the general purpose loggers.

Logger32

Logger 32 is a general purpose logger that has computer interface support for many radios but no cluster interface. It works with Windows 95 to XP and should work with later operating systems. It is available at www.logger32.net/

XMLOG

XMLOG is a general purpose logger with rig support, cluster support, cw and even prints QSL labels. It works with all versions of windows from 95 thru Win 7. It can import and export logs in either ADIF or CSV formats. It can be found at www.xmlog.com

Ham Radio Deluxe

Ham Radio Deluxe is a general purpose logger that also supports some contests although you might have to get the contest module from a third party. It works on Windows 2000 thru Win 7 and may also work on Win98. It has rig and cluster

support and also has a module that does the digital modes. It uses Open Database Connectivity (ODBC) to allow import/export from its Access database. You can download it at www.ham-radio-deluxe.com/.

Now a couple of contest loggers

CT

CT is the granddaddy of them all. It is no longer supported but still available from KIEA. You can get it as a DOS program or a character mode version, CT for Windows. It may not interface with the newer rigs but has packet cluster support.



NIMM Logger

NIMM Logger is the logging program we use on Field Day. It has support for all rigs, cluster support, cw mode and runs all digital modes. They have a very active group that is always correcting bugs and adding features. From the web site you can look at the two Email support group reflectors (General and Digital) and search the archives if you have a problem. It runs on Windows NT thru Win7. It stores the log in an Access 2000 database and you can import and export ADIF files. You can download it at http://nlmm.hamdocs.com/.
