This bonus is not available for individual participants or for simply posting on your club website about your Field Day operations. It is for actively promoting Field Day using social media during the weekend.

allows groups and clubs operating as Class A in the field to earn a 100- point bonus by having a safety officer for their operation who ensures its overall safe operation. This is more than simply appointing someone to be the safety officer. In order to earn this bonus, the safety officer must complete a check-list of key safety issues to ensure they have been addressed.
