FIELD DAY WRAP UP

Well another Field Day is in the books. It didn't rain and the hot weather waited a few days to show up. Everything went fairly smooth during the setup. The crew shooting the ropes over the lights did well this year. They got the first pole on the third shot after I evoked the name of Paul KC2ITU who had the magic touch last year. That technique also worked on the second pole. Nothing worked on the third so we didn't use it and tied both Windom's to the second pole. Murphy made his presence known later that night when the hard drive crashed on the VHF computer. Noel got it back up but it reloaded all the Q's that it had made into the other two logging computers causing dupes. That was no problem as the contacts were not counted. It was a problem later when the drive died for good so, we shut down the VHF station and just ran the other two. On Sunday we re-configured the TS2000 to run as the phone station to give the phone operators a chance to use it as it may be the phone station rig next year.

The phone station Q's were up by 46 this year while the CW station was down by 70. Most of this was due to the bands being dead on Saturday. Sunday was better and 10 meters opened up enough so that the CW station could work 10 Q's and the Phone station 8. This is three years in a row now that 10 has been dead.

The 2014 bonus points total was 750 while it was 970 for 2013. We lost points because of three things. No elected official visited, no youth element this year and no media publicity.

The log was uploaded to LoTW. When it was processed we already had over 80 confirmations including ones from the WIAW centennial stations.

Thanks again to everyone who helped with the setup and takedown along with manning the stations. A special thanks to our friends at the Morris Township OEM for their help with the trailer, generator and transporting the tower.


