CONSTITUTIONAL VOTE

There will be a vote at the Monday meeting to make two minor adjustments to the Constitution. In Article IV Section 4 Duties of the Secretary it states that the name of the newsletter is "QRM" and that it should be issued a minimum of seven days prior to the monthly meeting. A quick search shows that there are at least ten other clubs with a newsletter named "QRM". It is recommended that the name of the newsletter be removed so that if required it can be changed in the future without changing the Constitution. It is also recommended that the seven days prior to the meeting be changed to four days minimum as issuing it too early defeats the purpose of serving as a reminder for the upcoming meeting.

Existing sentence:

In addition, the Secretary shall issue monthly the newsletter, "QRM", which shall provide the membership with a minimum of 7 days notice of meetings and other information of interest to the members.

Proposed sentence:

In addition, the Secretary shall issue a monthly newsletter which shall provide the membership with a minimum of 4 days notice of meetings and other information of interest to the members.


