THIS YEAR IT LOOKS LIKE WE'RE #3

On Monday November 9th the December issue of QST was released in digital form. I can't find any of us listed individually but the MRC is listed under the Club Aggregate Score category. It looks like Garden State ARA is first in NNJ with a score of 10,825 and 15 individual entries. New Providence is second with 10,790 points and 12 entries. We're third with 8.500 points and 8 entries. Splitrock came in fifth with 3,126 points and 7 entries. The searchable database is not up yet so I can't get the NNJ and Hudson Division breakdowns. It usually takes them a couple of weeks to get that up and when they do I'll try to do a more detailed breakdown. The total number of entries in-

creased by more than three times but, the total number of participants was down. Over 80% of the entries were from home stations. Total contacts rose by 70%. 44% were CW almost double from last vear. There were 1.862.982 QSO's made The MRC members who submitted entries were K2EMJ, KC2RDX, N1MID, NO2EL. W2GM. WA2IMS. WA2VQF and WR2G. Hopefully we'll be close to normal next year and be able to be in the field again. Thanks to everyone who participated this year. 
