## CQ WPX CW RESULTS

The results of the CQ WPX CW Contest have been posted. Craig WR2G came in 14th in the 2nd Call Area, 112th in North America and 302 in the world. He had 963 QSO's and 619 Call Prefixes. Craig operated 25.9 hours in the Single Operator High Power All band category. Bill WA2VQF came in 28th in the 2nd Call Area 324th in North America and 1179 in the World. He had 166 QSO's and 115 unique Call Prefixes. Bill worked 10.5 hours in the Single Operator Low Power All Band category.

## JUNE VHF CONTEST RESULTS

The ARRL June VHF Contest results have been posted and Noel NO2EL came in 25th out of 665 entries in the Single Operator Low Power Category. Noel gathered 266 QSO's in 32.8 hours of operation.

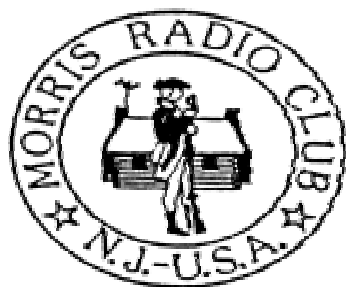
